# Kansai University Minami-Senri International Plaza International Students Dormitory



This is a dormitory for international students located in a quiet residential area, and 15 minutes away by bicycle from Kansai University's Senriyama Campus. International students at Kansai University are the main residents in this dormitory, and Resident Assistants (RA) also live there to support their daily life in Japan. All rooms are single occupancy with each unit composed of 6-7 rooms, and a shared kitchen and lounge so that students can spend time together. Cultural exchange events are held with people from the local community.

There are supermarkets, drug stores, banks, and a post office in front of Minami-Senri station.

What should I prepare before checking in to the dormitory?

Please organize your own tableware such as dishes and chopsticks, and other amenities such as towels. Furniture (bed, desk, chair, refrigerator, etc.) and bedding (pillow, comforter, mattress, covers) are provided by the dormitory.

Are meals provided in the dormitory?

The dormitory does not have a cafeteria, so you will have to prepare meals on your own. Each unit has a kitchen with a microwave oven and a toaster.

Is there a curfew?

No, there is no curfew. The entrance door is self-locking, but you can go in and out freely. The dormitory manager is on duty at the entrance for 24 hours, so it is fully secure.

What kind of rules are there?

Here are some typical dormitory rules for communal living.

- Drinking is not permitted outside the dormitory rooms.
- · Smoking is not permitted inside the dormitory. (Smoking is permitted only the designated smoking space.)
- Non-residents are not allowed to enter the living space. (Non-residents are allowed to see residents in the multipurpose room only.)
- Entering the units and the rooms of the opposite sex is not permitted.


