## 略歷

Peter D. MacIntyre is professor of psychology at Cape Breton University (Canada). His research focusses on the psychology of language and communication, including anxiety, motivation and willingness to communicate. He has written books or edited anthologies on Positive Psychology, Motivational Dynamics. Nonverbal Communication, Teaching Innovations, and Language Learner Individual Differences.

## 概要

Positive psychology has taken root in second language acquisition (SLA) and is growing rapidly. It provides innovative research directions into familiar topics, new areas of research, and applications to teaching. Positive psychology informs traditional topics in language learning but also introduces new topics not yet widely studied, such as hope, resiliency, and strengths. This presentation will review the current state of positive psychology in SLA and propose directions for future development, including the need for applied classroom research.
