About program

While studying at Kansai University, participants will take courses in Japanese language, career education, and internships, and will also gain approximately two months of internship experience during the exchange program period. This program is highly recommended for those who are considering a career using Japanese or pursuing a career in Japan in the future.

✓ **Number of applicants : Approx. 6 students (*Plan)**

✓ **Scholarship : JPY 80,000 / per month**

※The scholarship period is aligned with the duration of the program and may vary depending on the number of participants and the length of study abroad.

✓ **Program Period : September to January or July**

※Depending on the duration of study abroad.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements.

- ①Interested in pursuing a career utilizing Japanese in the future
- ②Japanese proficiency at approximately JLPT N3 level (J-CAT, BJT, J-TEST, or equivalent accepted)
- ③Able to complete required courses, attend seminars, and participate in an internship during the program period
- ④Must meet the eligibility requirements for the JASSO scholarship (*See application guidelines for details)

- ②Submit all required documents via Dropbox by the application deadline.

●If you do not have a JLPT N3 level

- ①Scan the QR code to visit the website and review the application guidelines.
- ②Submit all required documents via Dropbox by the application deadline.
- ③Take Kansai University's designated Japanese language test.(Deadline: July 12)

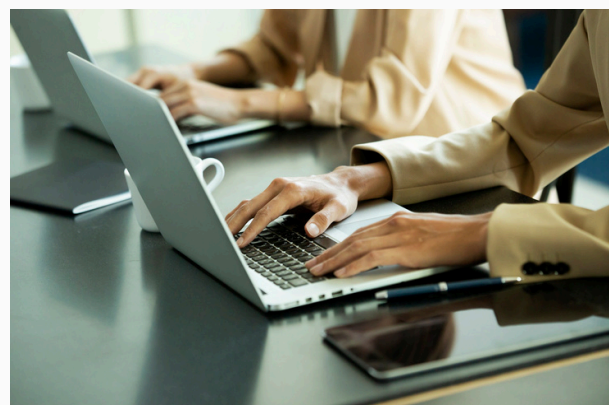
