

UMAP-COIL Joint Program (Multilateral COIL course) 2020

Program Overview 募集要項

0. Purpose 開催趣旨

- 1) The pandemic damage on international education around the world is indeed devastating. Very little hope for traditional mobility for students and staffs exists, for the current time, and even after we pass this critical phase, a most likely expectation is that there will be diverse combination of on-site and off-site learning (and working) will continue to be options now, even more so than ever.
- 2) In the meantime when no studying abroad experience can be presented to the students, HEIs are still in need to educate the youth to assure intercultural competency as one of their very important graduate attributes. We can even more strongly argue that global citizenry competence is in most demand because of this time of crisis; how we co-create the forthcoming new phase of the world after the pandemic is so critical to determine the future.
- 3) With this reasons and background contexts, we would like to propose a new shape of UMAP-COIL Joint Program for 2020, which is going to be conducted 100% online, yet provide ample of opportunities for UMAP students to gain enriched learning and international experience from it. IIGE (Institute for Innovative Global Education) at Kansai University has been collaborating with UMAP for the past year. We carried out a UMAP-COIL Joint Honors Program in the summer 2019, with online component combined with a physical study abroad in Japan. We would like to continue our collaborative partnership in 2020 and on, by proposing another joint program.
- 4) IIGE/Kansai University promotes COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) as an additional teaching and learning practice in international education since 2014. With our knowledge and experience to promote virtual exchange among students from different backgrounds, we are confident in generating an online course this summer. The tentative details of the proposed program will follow below.

Students will examine a range of broad themes relating to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, including topics on foreign policy, international affairs, trade and finance, and defense and security. In addition, we will explore more specific areas of contemporary interest, for example aspects of health and wellbeing, international approaches to education, and business innovation and development.
