Local Trip: Explore Taiwan's Classic Must-Visit Attractions!

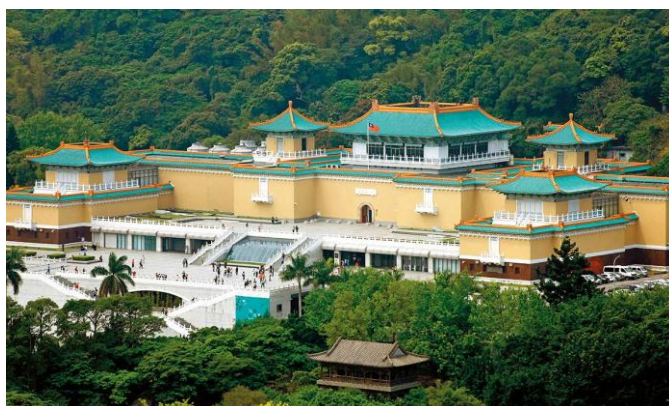
- Jiufen Old Street/九份老街: Stroll through the nostalgic hillside town, savor local delicacies, and enjoy stunning ocean and mountain views.



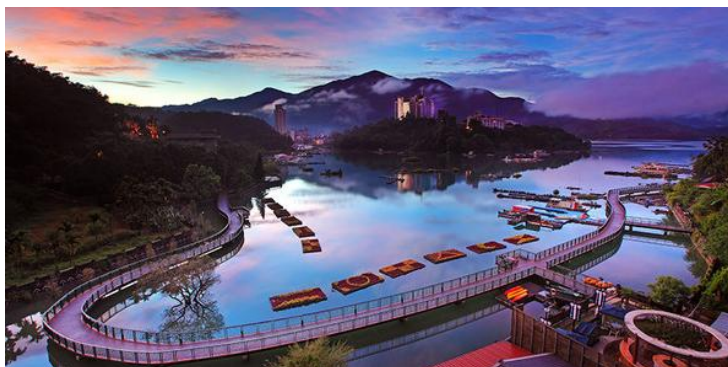
- Yehliu Geopark/野柳地質公園: Discover fascinating rock formations and capture the iconic “Queen’s Head” natural wonder.

2. Program Fee

The program fee this year is **US\$1,050** or **US\$1,200**/person.

3. Recommended Airport and Arrival Time

Please choose **Taoyuan International Airport** (IATA: TPE).

Arrival time on March 1st can be between 9:00 and 21:00 (**accommodation check-in time: after 15:00**), and departure time will be at noon on March 21st (**check-out time: before 11:00**). *Please note that our school can provide airport pick-up service only **between 9:00 and 21:00 on March 1st**.* We kindly request that you arrange your flight to arrive within this time frame so our staff can warmly welcome and assist you upon arrival.

- Deadline of the application is **November 30, 2025**. Please complete the **Application Form** and send it to incoming_exchange@cycu.edu.tw before the deadline.
- Fee due date is **January 15, 2026**.

5. About the Accommodation

We'll arrange all participants to stay in the on-campus Guest House. The facilities of the guest house are as follows: washing & clothes dryer machine (coin-operated), drinking fountain. Inside the room, there are hair dryer, television, fridge, kettle, air conditioner, and internet service.



Please note that starting in 2025, in response to the government's environmental protection policy, our school guesthouse will no longer provide single-use amenities. **Participants are kindly asked to bring their own personal toiletries**, such as towels, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, and body wash, etc. If needed, these items can also be purchased in Taiwan.
