- \*\* All other initial application fees are <u>waived</u> for exchange students. Waived fees include:
  - \$40 international admission fee
  - \$500 international student enrollment fee
- 1) Special Application for Non-Degree Students (online application, link will be sent to students each term)
- Application for Immigration Document https://uscips.wufoo.com/forms/exchange-application-for-immigration-document/
- 3) English-proficiency official scores, mentioned above.
- \*\*use code 5818 for USC and send an unofficial copy to our office IELTS 6.5
- \*Be advised that accepted scores may vary depending on exchange agreements\*
- 4) Photocopy of official transcripts
- 5) Immunization Form
- 6) Certification of Financial Support Form
  - Exchange students must certify for living expenses (housing, food, books, health insurance, miscellaneous):
    - \$9,907 US per semester (4 months)\*\*
    - \$21,571 US per academic year (9 months)\*\*

- 7) Photocopy of passport (high resolution scan please)

Documents 3-7 should be uploaded to the student's Study Abroad Account. Students will be given complete instructions following nomination.

Medical Insurance** *Insurance fees are based upon academic year 2020-2021 and are subject to change	Compulsory medical insurance may be applied prior to or upon arrival on campus. 2020-2021 fees are \$1,031.28 US per fall semester and \$1401.72* per spring/summer semester. If a student can provide proof of requisite health insurance coverage, this fee may be waived after arrival. Insurance policies must meet <b>ALL coverage requirements</b> in order to successfully waive the UofSC policy.
