APPLICATION PROCEDURE INFORMATION

Nomination Process: partners to send nomination details by email (ie: name, email, start month, duration, subject area & level of study while at NU) and after the deadline has passed, each student will receive individual email instructions on how to apply online.

Nomination Deadlines:

Semester 1 (September) – 1st April 2021 Semester 2 (January) – 1st October 2021

Application Deadlines: students to complete online application form and submit all supporting documents. Semester 1 (September) – Friday 16 April 2021 Semester 2 (January) – Friday 22 October 2021

Portfolio Guidance: Students applying for any Art, Architecture or Design course will be required to submit a portfolio of relevant work with their application form and should research the individual programme's portfolio guidance online.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

English presessional course - details about studying English with NU before starting your exchange studies.

<u>English Requirements</u> - the following minimum requirements are generally for undergraduate non final year exchange study, any unique English requirements will be noted within the relevant institutional agreement.

IELTS: overall 6.0 (with minimum of 5.5 in each component) **TOEFL IBT**: overall 79 (with minimum R18, W17, L17, S20)

<u>Acceptable English Qualifications</u> - find out about recognised English tests, any acceptable country specific qualifications and relevant exemptions.
