Konkuk University does not facilitate off-campus housing.</p>
Living Costs	USD 400~600 / month (varies depending upon the lifestyle of students)
Visa	All exchange students must obtain a D-2-6 (exchange student) visa in order to study at Konkuk University. Upon admission, students will receive the 'Certificate of Admission' which is required to apply for the visa. Students should contact the Korean consulate in their home countries for details.
Medical Insurance	All exchange students must have basic international medical insurance coverage. It is their responsibility to purchase their own insurance coverage prior to coming to Korea.
Facilities	University hospital, library, computer rooms, on-campus dormitory, cafeterias, adjacent subway (metro) system, adjacent shopping malls, etc.
