ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Visa Requirements

D-2 (Student Visa)

Students must apply for a D-2 visa via the Korean Embassy/Consulate in their home country.

CREDIT

1 Course = 3 US credits at KNU in general.
For some majors, there are 2-credit courses.

3 US Credits = 45 hours of work, including classes and related academic activities.

MINIMUM/MAXIMUM CREDITS

Minimum Credits:

- 6 Credits / Semester

Undergraduate Students:

- Maximum 21 Credits / Semester
- Including internships

Graduate Students:

- Maximum 9 Korean Credits
- 3 Courses
- Including internship credits

ACCOMMODATIONS

- On-campus housing is available at approximately USD \$500 per semester. Housing cafeteria three meals per day is approximately USD \$600 per semester.
- All exchange students' on-campus housing (dormitory) is guaranteed if they apply.
- Students who wish to stay off-campus must inform the exchange program manager and find housing for themselves.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

- It is mandatory for all international students studying in Korea to have insurance that covers medical expenses in Korea.
- Medical benefits of at least USD \$20,000 per accident or illness
- A deductible not to exceed 20% per accident or illness
- Repatriation of remains in the amount of USD \$10,000
- Medical evacuation in the amount of USD \$10,000 in the event an exchange visitor must be returned to his or her home country due to a serious medical condition

MEDICAL-EXAM CERTIFICATE

Confirming Absence of Tuberculosis

According to a new legislation by the Korean government, the KNU housing office requires all dormitory residents to submit a medical certificate including a physician's written statement in ENGLISH or KOREAN, confirming the absence of tuberculosis.

Students must bring the ORIGINAL medical certificate. It is mandatory for all students who want to use on-campus housing to submit a medical certificate due to safety reasons. The certificate must be submitted within 2 months from the time of test results.
