■授業概要・到達目標	■授業概要 <秋> This course is intended to familiarize students with an introductory knowledge of the history, theories, concepts, and key themes in international development and volunteerism, and an awareness of some issues and concerns in the field. International development aims to explain both the diversity evident in the world in relation to human well-being and the common patterns that emerge when comparing people, social groups, nations, economic and political systems, and regions of the world. In the volunteerism field, since it has become more vital for nonprofit organizations to provide services that directly affect our quality of life, effective management of volunteer resources will be shown. ■到達目標 <秋> By the end of this course students should have an introductory knowledge as follows: 1.The history and theory of international development; how this influences development policy and practice; the organizations involved in development and the impacts of different approaches. 2.Key themes, with special focus on development as it intersects with human rights and democracy, health, the environment, rural development, food security, poverty, and famine. 3.The role of civil society in development and various development projects. 4.Practical guidance on such essential issues as motivating people to volunteer their time and services, and recruitment. 5.Volunteer demographics, volunteer program leaders and managers, policy making and implementation, planning and staff analysis, recruiting, interviewing and screening volunteers, orienting and training volunteers.
