概要

Group discussions can be a way to get students interacting with each other in English for long stretches of time. In this workshop, one approach to incorporating discussions into content-based Listening & Speaking classes will be introduced. By providing students with three main areas to focus on, the course textbook topics and activities are incorporated to move students toward three speaking targets. In group discussions, students (1) use specific vocabulary from the textbook, (2) include discussion strategies, and (3) express opinions and ideas with explanations, reasons, and details. From week 1, students understand that they should be working on these three targets in every discussion that they have. Some of the simple classroom activities we do – such as using word cards – to work on these areas of speaking will be explained.
