Part 1: Intonation and Stress as Communication **David HEYWOOD 先生（特任外国語講師）**

This short workshop will consider the importance of intonation and stress in English communication. It is difficult for many Japanese students to consistently use intonation and stress 'correctly', but it is a useful way for speakers to make their meaning and intention clear to listeners. Simple, interactive activities will be suggested to help students gain awareness of this speaking skill, by practicing using and listening for intonation and stress.

Part 2: The Ethics of AI in (Language) Education **Dragana LAZIC 先生（特任外国語講師）**

The integration of AI into education has emerged as a transformative force, bringing unprecedented opportunities to enhance learners' skills development. However, with great opportunities, come significant risks of misuse if new technologies are not applied ethically. This short workshop examines some ethical considerations surrounding the adoption of AI tools in language classrooms by providing insights into the latest AIED (Artificial Intelligence in Education) research, ethical dilemmas and their implications.
