As AI becomes increasingly embedded in our lives and classrooms, instructors continue to struggle with assignments and how to evaluate student writing. Generative large language models (LLMs) produce polished finished products, preventing students from developing their own voice and evolving as writers. This presentation argues that the key to addressing this over-focus on finished, possibly student-made, writing lies in re-centering the writing process itself - both inside and outside the classroom. The presenters put forth two actionable, student-centered approaches to process writing: one intentionally avoiding AI tools, and one purposefully embracing them.
